Lake Placid Attorney Allison M. McGahay Announces Candidacy for Supreme Court Justice of the 4th Judicial District

Essex County Attorney Seeks to Return Seat to Elizabethtown After 14 Year Absence

Elizabethtown, NY: At the historic Essex County Court house built in 1823, Essex County Attorney and Republican Election Commissioner, Allison McGahay officially launched her campaign for Supreme Court Justice of the Fourth Judicial District. “I am proud to be here with so many of my colleagues to officially announce my candidacy before friends, family, coworkers and those whom I admire and greatly respect,” said Allison McGahay. “As a longtime Essex County public servant, first as an Assistant District Attorney and now as the Commissioner of the Board of Elections, I am prepared to take on the task of returning a Supreme Court Justice to the seat of County Government here in Elizabethtown.”

The 4th JD encompasses eleven (11) Counties from Saratoga County to the Canadian Border north and from Washington County, west to Fulton County. With over 500,000 registered voters, and a population of over 840,00 residents, the 4th JD is one of the largest judicial districts in New York State.

Essex County had a seated Supreme Court Judge for close to 100 years until 2008 when the incumbent Essex County Supreme Court Justice was defeated. “It is time now to correct the imbalance of the number of Judges that are seated in the southern part of the 4th JD. Essex County is solely in the Adirondack Park and deserves a sitting Supreme Court Justice,” said Shaun Gilliland, Chairman of the Essex County Board of Supervisors. “I am standing here with my fellow Supervisors to strongly support Allison McGahay’s candidacy. We have all worked with Allison over the years and have been extremely impressed with her professionalism, dedication and commitment to public service on behalf of Essex County residents.”

“As an attorney in public service, I have always used the law to protect the vulnerable and the innocent. As a justice of the Supreme Court, it is important to understand the issues facing people from all walks of life to find practical, fair outcomes. I will be a justice for the people. My experience, qualifications and temperament are well-suited to successfully resolve cases providing fair outcomes,” McGahay said.

McGahay is endorsed by the Saratoga, Washington, Essex, Clinton, Montgomery, Fulton and Hamilton Republican committees and the St. Lawrence Conservative Committee.
