## **Allison McGahay Receives Republican and Conservative Party Nominations for Supreme Court Justice**

### ***McGahay Positioned to Be First Woman Elected Supreme Court Justice Solely in the Adirondack Park***

*Lake Placid, NY:* This week, 4<sup>th</sup> Judicial Republican and Conservative Delegates conducted nominating conventions in Saratoga Springs and Queensbury, NY to nominate 3 Supreme Court Justices. Delegates from both conventions selected Allison McGahay to be their official nominee for the upcoming November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022, general election.

“I am honored and grateful to have earned the nomination of the Delegates from both conventions. I will work intently every day to fulfill their trust in my candidacy,” said Allison McGahay. “From criminal law to municipal law to election law, I have the experience and the temperament necessary to dispense justice efficiently and effectively as a member of the Supreme Court,” said McGahay. “As a longtime Essex County public servant, first as an Assistant District Attorney and former Commissioner of the Board of Elections, I am committed to honoring tradition and returning a Supreme Court Justice to Essex County and the North Country.”

The 4<sup>th</sup> JD encompasses eleven (11) Counties from Saratoga County to the Canadian Border north and from Washington County, west to Fulton County. With over 500,000 registered voters, and a population of over 840,00 residents, the 4<sup>th</sup> JD is one of the largest judicial districts in New York State.

Essex County had a seated Supreme Court Judge for close to 100 years until 2008 when the incumbent Essex County Supreme Court Justice was defeated. Saratoga Springs Attorney, Chris Obstarczyk and Saratoga County Surrogate Court Judge Rich Kupferman also received the Republican nomination and will join McGahay on the ballot.

Concluded McGahay, “In public service, I have always used the law to protect the vulnerable and the innocent. As a justice of the Supreme Court, I will be a justice for the people.”
